- c. The development is not within the Local Plan for Folkestone and Hythe District Council
- d. Highway safety during construction and after the completion of the development.
- e. Site of Archaeological interest.
- f. Loss of grazing/farming land

5. To consider and comment on the following Planning Application-

24/0520/FH LAND ADJOINING HIGHKNOCKE FARM, SEABOURNE WAY, DYMCHURCH Outline planning application for a residential development of up to 125 dwellings with all matters reserved.
